


Friday 26 th February 2021


World Book Day 2021

I have really enjoyed helping the children with their turn taking skills when we play fetch!




Soda's St. Peter's expectations

Dothill Nature Reserve

Since I was 5 I have helped a local volunteer group called Friends of Dothill Nature Reserve (My grandad is one of the friends). This week I have been planting new trees because the old ones have been dying of a tree disease called ash dieback. Last summer I took part in a mammal study so we can learn what types of mammals are on the reserve. We found voles and shrews. Me and my dad also helped the Friends build a wetland area to attract different species of birds to the reserve. I love being part of the group because I can help the wildlife in my local area, and also help to give people somewhere nice to visit.
