



PSHE

This term, we will be looking at: healthy choices and habits; what affects feelings; expressing feelings, personal strengths and achievements; managing and reframing setbacks, risks and hazards; safety in the local environment and unfamiliar places.

Music

This term, we will be gaining an understanding of structure and musical processes, before creating melodic repeating patterns.

Science

Our theme this term is light and dark and magnetism. For our light topic, we will explore where light comes from and how we can see it, which materials are reflective and how shadows are formed. For magnetism, we will look at contact and non-contact forces and magnetic materials.

For PE this term, we will be taking part in athletics activities to develop our running, jumping, throwing and catching skills, as well as working on improving our communication and collaboration skills.

French

We will be focusing on learning simple phrases relating to the topics 'Our School' and 'Time'.

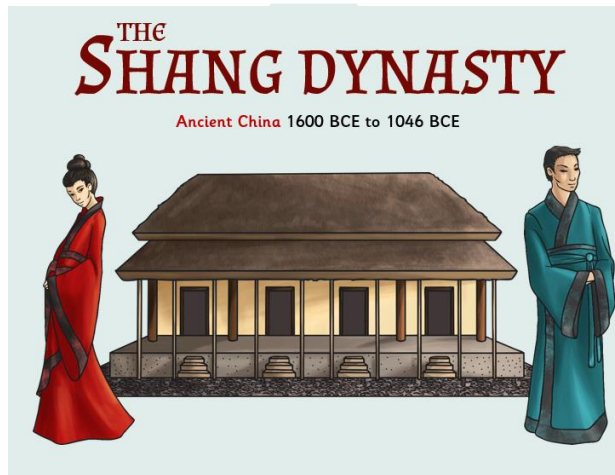
Maths
