UPDATES AND INFORMATION

Attendance, appointments and lateness

This is a reminder about what to do if your child is unwell or has an unavoidable medical appointment.

If your child is unwell, please telephone school (01952 387980) or drop into the office between 8:30am and before 10am in the morning to notify school. You will need to do this for every day your child is off unless the office staff have advised otherwise. It really helps school if you can do this.

Please note we only accept telephone calls for illness we cannot accept emails. Why? Anybody can write an email and we need to be certain it is a genuine call.

Why do we need to do this?

Legally, all school age children should attend school unless unwell. Apart from this we do care about children's safety and well-being. This first day calling stems from a safeguarding case many years ago. Some of you will remember the 'SOHAM incident' in 2002. Parents thought the children were safely in school and school thought they were safely at home. At this time, calling school was not a requirement.

There was a sad outcome. Since then it is expected that parents and guardians notify school if they are going to be off.

What happens if you forget to call?

The office staff will try to contact you from 10am in the morning using all of the contacts you have provided. If they cannot contact anybody then school will do a 'safe and well' check at 11am and come out to your house to make sure you and your family are ok. If you are not in they will leave a letter asking you to contact school.

In extreme cases we will call the police if we have concerns.

Occasionally, the office staff will advise you that you don't need to call the school. For example, a sickness bug- your child will need to be off for 48 hours from the last episode of sickness. The staff member will tell you when the child can return to school (unless your child has another episode) and that we will mark the child as absent for the next day and you don't need to call.

Unavoidable Medical Appointments.

If your child has a medical appointment that you can only arrange in the school day please follow this procedure.

In this case you can send an email (stpetersbratton@taw.org.uk) before the day of the appointment with the appointment card or letter or a screenshot of the appointment. We store these in your child's personal folder.

Please do not send emails to the year group emails as the teachers only looks at these when they have time and will not routinely review the emails.

If it is an emergency appointment, please bring in the letter or appointment when you pick up your child.

Always allow plenty of time for your child to be collected.

Lateness.

School officially begins at 9am. If your child arrives after 9am and before 9:30am they will be marked as late. (L on the register) If your child arrives after 9:30 they will be marked as an unauthorised absence (U on the register) and this will affect their attendance. We regularly review attendance- a one off lateness when the car has broken down, or you have overslept- this happens to everyone and you do not need to worry. However, if there are several lates then this will be reviewed.
