Percentage of pupils achieving the expected standard

Pupils are 'meeting the expected standard' if they achieve a 'scaled score' of 100 or more in their reading and mathematics tests, and their teacher assesses them as 'working at the expected standard' or better in writing.

Average score in reading

This score is known as the reading 'scaled score'. The score is an average for pupils in the school. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.

Average score in mathematics

This score is known as the mathematics 'scaled score'. The score is an average for pupils in the school. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard is 110 or more.

Percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard



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Pupils are 'achieving at a higher standard' if they achieve a 'scaled score' of 110 or more in their reading and mathematics tests, and their teacher assesses them as 'working at a greater depth within the expected standard' in writing.
