Big Ideas

Jesus offered friendship, forgiveness, and peace.

Does being thankful matter?

Spiritual Development

Reflecting on being thankful and how important this is to themselves and others.

Prior learning

Jesus brought good news because he was a friend to those left out by other people.

Jesus died on a cross and came back to life on Easter Sunday.

Key Aspects covered.

In this unit of RE work children will learn:

- How do our friends and family show kindness and love for their children.
- Gifts that God has provided to show his love.
- How God and Christians show how to be thankful through stores: Jesus and the 10 lepers.
- Christians pray because they think God is listening, and sometimes God answers prayers in good or surprising ways.
- How some people pray every day and some never pray at all.

- How does the Lord's prayer show God's love for humans and animals.
- The ten gifts God has given humans.
- How to reflect on their own beliefs and those of Christians when talking about being thankful.
