Unit name: What kind of king is Jesus?

## **Big Ideas**

Jesus told many parables about the Kingdom of God.

#### **Spiritual Development**

Developing and reflecting on own belief about roles and responsibilities.

#### **Prior learning**

Jesus died and was raised to life to bring in a new 'Kingdom' where God rules in people's lives.

Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus Christ.

#### Key Aspects covered.

In this unit of RE work children will learn:

- The Kingdom is compared to a feast where all are invited to join in. Not everyone chooses to do so.
- Explain connections between biblical texts and the concept of the Kingdom of God.
- Many Christians try to extend the Kingdom of God by challenging unjust social structures in their locality and in the world.

#### To know:

- connections between belief in the Kingdom of God and how Christians put their beliefs into practice in different ways.
- Stories that begin with 'The Kingdom of Heaven is like...' and explore the meaning.

### To explore:

• The lord's prayer and link this to discussion about heaven.

#### To Explain:

What Jesus meant in The Feast: Luke 14:12–24.
