Voluntary contribution for school visits:

I think there is a mis understanding about voluntary contributions for school visits and so I am sharing this to clarify and update you...

When we send out the information for school visits (not including residentials), the contribution you make to the visit is voluntary across those going on the visit, it covers the cost of the visit – it doesn't make a profit. Your child goes on the visit irrespective of how much you have paid. We are increasingly finding that parents are not making the voluntary contributions. School does not have the money to pay for educational visits for children – the funding is simply not there.

We are acutely aware of the financial pressures that many of you are facing. There are various visits we were planning but haven't proceeded with because they were either too expensive or the notice for them was too short. There are other visits that we have altered to reduce the cost.

From September, we will set a deadline date for voluntary contributions of visits to be received that is before the date we can cancel the visit with the organisation that we are visiting and the coach company that we are using - I.e., enabling us to cancel without incurring charges. If we haven't received enough voluntary contributions, we won't be able to allow the visit to carry on, as we don't have the funding to

keep making up the difference for so many pupils and we will then cancel the visit and refund the contributions made.

For those of you who have children who are eligible for Pupil Premium, LAC or PLAC or EHCPs; the funding your child receives doesn't cover educational visits. Voluntary contributions still need to be made for your children.

We are always happy to talk to parents who will have difficulty paying for visits and in those circumstances we can put in place a plan to pay over time. Please have a conversation with the school office about this.

They all played extremely well, even though they were the youngest team there. They have a few more tournaments coming up over the summer. Well done girls!






