Term: Autumn

Unit name: Families and Friendships– Roles of different people, families, feeling cared for.

Main concepts (families and friendships)

- about people who care for them, e.g. parents, siblings, grandparents, relatives, friends, teachers
- the role these different people play in children's lives and how they care for them
- that it means to be a family and how families are different, e.g. single parents, same-sex parents, etc.

• about the importance of telling someone — and how to tell them — if they are worried about something in their family

Prior knowledge.

Children should already...

- Know who is in their family.
- Know who they can talk to in school if they are worried about something.
- Know that lots of different people care for them.

Key vocabulary

Parent, sibling, sister, brother, grandparent, aunty, uncle, relative, family, friend, teacher, care, caring, rules, needs,

How the children are to be taught this.

PSHE should be delivered in mixed gender groups.
