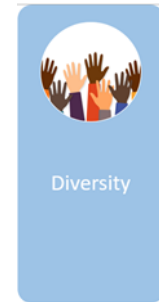

Unit name: Families and Friendships– Making friends, feeling lonely and getting help

Main concepts (families and friendships)

- how to be a good friend, e.g. kindness, listening, honesty
- about different ways that people meet and make friends
- strategies for positive play with friends, e.g. joining in, including others, etc.
- about what causes arguments between friends
- **how to positively resolve arguments between friends**
- how to recognise, and ask for help, when they are feeling lonely or unhappy or to help someone else

Prior knowledge.

Children should already...

- Know what it takes to be a good friend
- Know that friends will fall out and make up
- Know who they can go to for help in school and at home.

Key vocabulary

Friend, kind, honest, listen, caring, getting on, falling out, positive, negative, argument, making up, falling out, resolving, feeling, lonely, happy

How the children are to be taught this.
