Unit name: 1.1 What do Christians believe God is like?

Prior learning

God and Creation

This unit will explore what Christians believe about God and creation. In the light of these beliefs, Christians try to live in the ways God shows through the bible.

Key Aspects covered

In this unit of RE work children will know that:

- Christians read the Bible as telling a story of the relationship between God the Creator, and creation.
- The Bible explores ways in which God draws humans back into a close friendship with him so that everyone would want to be friends with God.
- The Bible can be used in human attempts to understand the nature of God.
- Christians believe that the Bible reveals what God is like, and that he is worth being friends with.
- Christians use the stories of Jesus in various ways.

Big Ideas

Christians believe that God is a kind, loving, fair and forgiving in nature father.

Christians believe that God forgives our wrong doings and welcomes us home.

Spirituality

God is that from which all love springs.

Knowledge expectations

Christians believe in God, and that they find out about God in the Bible.

Christians believe God is loving, kind, fair and forgiving, and also Lord and King.
