#### Big Ideas

Christians believe that the creation of the universe sets out all relationships between God, Universe and all life.

### **Prior learning**

#### Key Aspects covered

In this unit of RE work children will know that:

- The story of Creation opens the Bible and sets out the relationship between God, the universe and all life.
- God is powerful (and concerned with the role and value of life (Creation is prepared for life, with human life as the pinnacle, made in God's image).
- The Creation story says a great deal about the kind of God Christians (and Jewish people) believe in.
- Creation reveals the nature of God and the place of humans in the world.
- The wonders of the world we live in can inspire us to be creative, to care for the Earth and its creatures, or to study the world.
