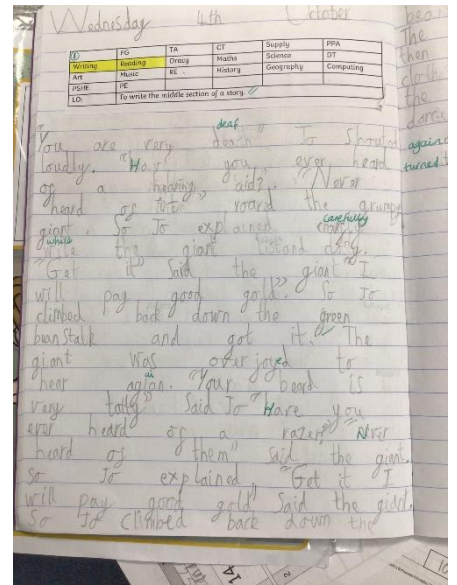
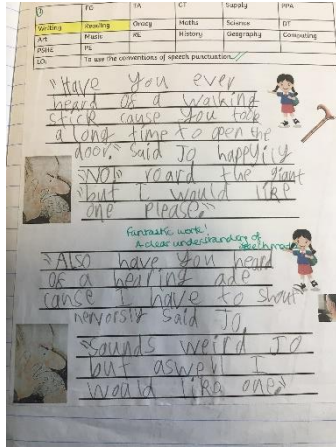
Year 1
