Voice machine

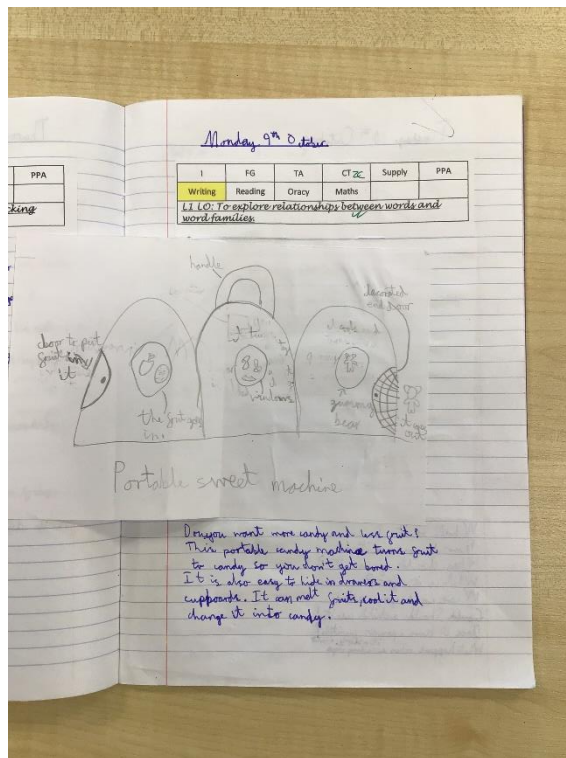
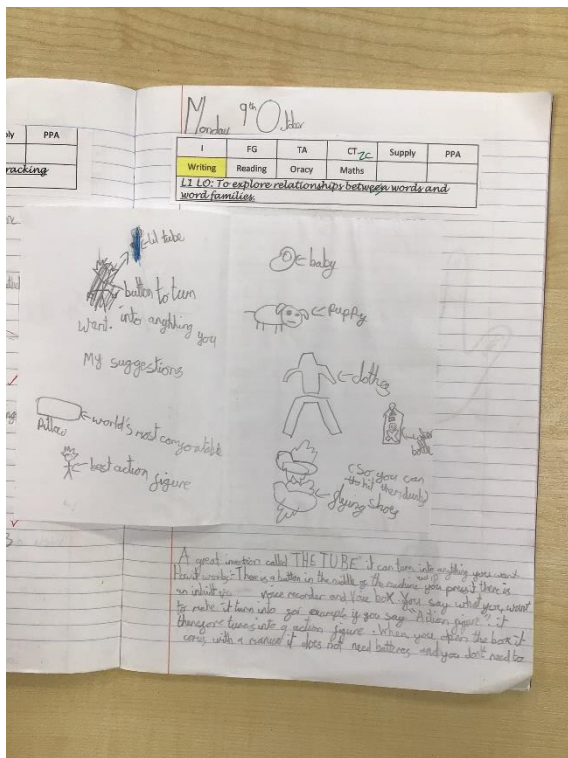
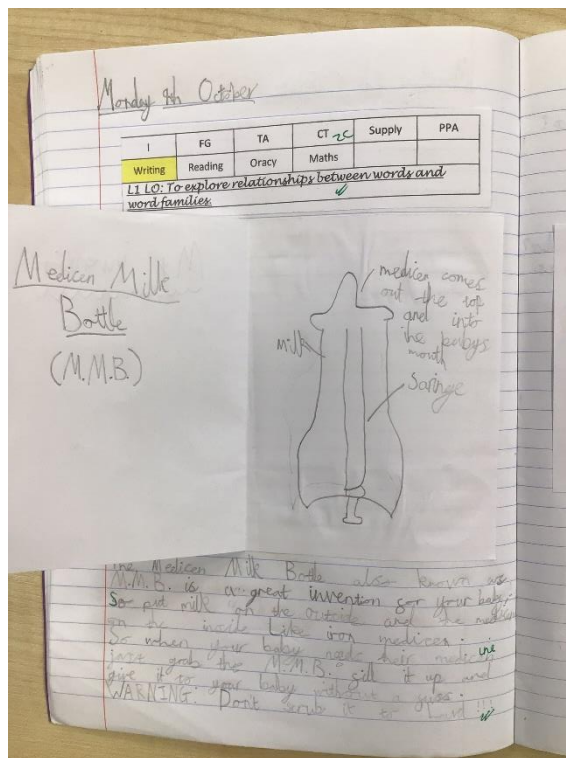
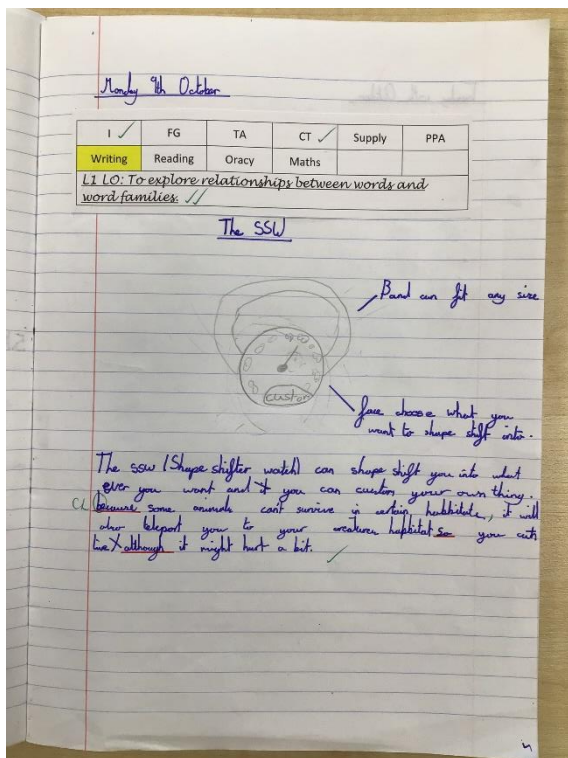
This machine changes your voice for 48 hours when you say someone's name in the mic.

Computing

Within computing, we have begun learning about photo editing. Throughout the unit, we will develop our understanding of how digital images can be changed and edited, and how they can then be resaved and reused. We will consider the impact that editing images can have and evaluate the effectiveness of our choices. We began the unit by physically cropping an image using scissors, before discussing the benefits that digital cropping has. Perhaps your child would like to share their thoughts on this with you!

Geography

We have almost come to the end of our geography learning on *Rivers and The Water Cycle* and have learnt so much about this unit! We can now identify the physical features of rivers, understand the different ways rivers can be used by humans and understand how the behaviour of humans can cause water pollution. We had lots of fun acting out and narrating the process of the water cycle and are looking forward to locating some of the major rivers on Earth, as well as understanding the importance of the River Severn on our local environment. We hope to end our learning with a water cycle investigation and look forward to sharing that with you.
