Christmas holiday club booking will open Friday 27th October 6:00pm and close Friday 15th December 6:00pm.

The cost per place booked is £25.00 a day. Once booked sessions will need to be paid for before the child attends club.

Children will need to be provided with a piece of fruit or breakfast bar for morning snack, a packed lunch for lunchtime and a small afternoon snack, all food that is brought in must not contain nuts.

Children are welcome to bring in scooters and bikes with helmets to play on outside or a small toy to play inside during free play.
