Key Aspects covered

In this unit of RE work children will know:

- Hot cross buns are traditionally eaten on Good Friday.
- Easter is a happy celebration as Jesus didn't stay dead.
- The Easter story and why it is important event in the Christian calendar.
- The palm cross reminds Christians that although crowds were happy to see Jesus some people were jealous of him.

Knowledge expectations

- To know what a palm cross is and why it is special.
- To know that one of Jesus' followers betrayed him.
- To know that Jesus died on a cross and that he was buried in a cave (tomb) in a garden.
- To know that he came back to life, and this called Easter Sunday.
