Unit name: Holy Words – Why do religious people love their scripture? (Islam Focus)

Prior learning

Pupils know special books of Muslims and Christians.

Pupils know Islamic stories learnt and understand the meanings of these stories.

Pupils know that Muslim's God is Allah.

Key Aspects covered

In this unit of RE work children will know:

- Why some books are special
- The key belief that there is no other God but Allah
- Why the Qu'ran is important to Muslims.
- What can be learnt from the Bible stories about God.
- To think about the difference between Bible and Qu'ran and some similarities.

Big Ideas

Pupils understand that Muslims and Christians pray to a God.

Pupils can explain who Prophet Muhammad is and why he is important to Muslims.

The Qu'ran is the holy book of Islam and guides Muslims in their daily life.

Knowledge expectations
