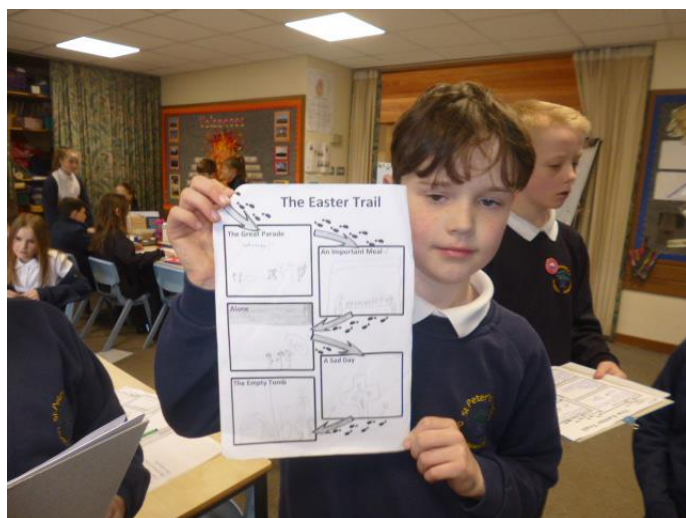
We are looking forward to our school trip to Wroxeter Roman City next Wednesday and thank parents/carers for their support.
