## English

## Maths

We will be learning where the Vikings came from, who they were and why they came to Britain. This will include how they transported themselves around the world and how did their relationship with Britain end.

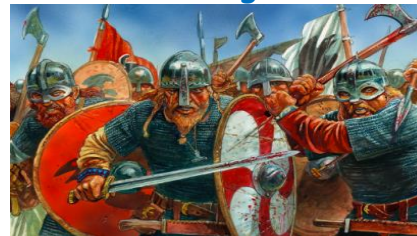
## Computing-Vector Drawing
