We will be learning about the differences in life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. We will also be describing the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

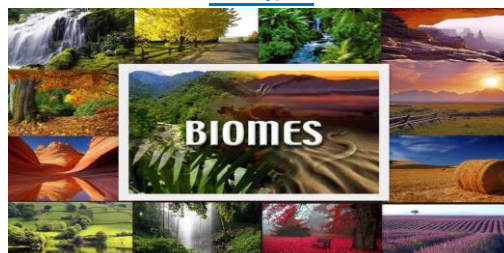
Religious Education

Geography-Biomes
