Autumn Term 2019



English

This term we will be using themed texts. Our outcomes will include: retelling the stories, writing a diary, creating a chronological report, a recount of a theatrical workshop. We also will be meeting the author of one of our texts.

Science

This term our focus will be on Materials. We will be naming different materials and considering their properties. We are going to be completing lots of mini investigations including making and testing slime.

History

Our history will be split into two different focuses: the Great Fire of London and then the Gunpowder Plot. We will learn about each of these and then consider how these are remembered and why.

Computing

As always we will ensure the children understand Online-Safety. We will be considering the uses of technology and using a range of programs to present information in different ways

Bratton Passport at Home

New this term we will asking you to complete three tasks with your child at home:

Geography

In Geography we will be locating London and using maps to show how the Great Fire of London Spread. We will be using compass points. We will also look at maps showing the Houses of Parliament.

RE

The RE in this term falls into 2 units: The Creation of God's World and Incarnation where we will be learning more about the people who were present at the birth of Jesus.

Art and DT

In Art we will be learning to mix a range of shades and tones which reflect flames. Then we will be working on a collaborative piece of artwork with Year 6 partners. In DT we will be making wheeled vehicles.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be understanding place value to 100 and beyond, becoming more efficient with addition and subtraction, adding totals with money and learning to multiply and divide by 2,5,10.

PSHE and SMSC

In PSHE we will establish our class rules. Then we will be learning about being healthy and looking after our teeth. In SMSC we will discuss being British, understand how parliament works and the role of the Police.

Music

We will be focusing on singing rhymes and chants, then move onto composing our own music. Following on from this we will learn and perform songs as part of the Nativity performance at Church.
