

English

This term we will be using different texts. Our writing outcomes will include: writing a story opening, a non-chronological report, character descriptions, descriptive poems and retelling a familiar story.



Science

This term our units will be on materials and mixing and making. Some of our lessons include: How can the shape of solid objects be changed? Which material is the stretchiest? Which materials are absorbent? Which mixture makes the best bubbles? How can I separate a mixture?



Computing

We will be developing the children's understanding of information technology and how it is used at home, in the world, how to use technology safely and the responsibility associated with those



Music

Our music units are pulse and metre and tempo, dynamics, timbre. In the first unit we will create simple patterns and begin to understand how sound can be represented by symbols. In the second unit we will be thinking about high/low loud/quiet sounds and changes in tempo.

RE

In RE in this term we will be learning about the Jewish faith. We will learn about the importance of Moses and Abraham, find out about some Jewish festivals and also how and where Jews worship.



Art

Our history units are the Gunpowder plot and the Great fire of London. We will find out who Guy Fawkes was, why he wanted to blow up the houses of Parliament and how Bonfire Night is celebrated, How the Great fire started, How it was put out and what the impact was.



Maths

This term in Maths we will be following Power Maths. Our units are: Understanding numbers to 100, Addition and subtraction, Money, and Multiplication and division. We will also be having a weekly arithmetic test and using times table rockstars to start learning our tables.



PSHE and SMSC

In PSHE we will focus on supporting our classes post lockdown. We will discuss why handwashing is important, things to play together but apart, expressing lockdown feelings, making kindness count and eating well.
