How to inform us about coronavirus over the half-term holiday:

For Isolation:

If your child has to isolate over the holidays because they or a member of the household is waiting for a test or they have been identified as having been in contact with a person who has tested positive for coronavirus, email the school on the usual email address stpetersbratton@taw.org.uk Let us know what has happened and when your child will be back in school. We will then call you on Monday 2nd November.

As a reminder, isolation is:

- 14 days from being in contact with an infected person (as long as you do not develop symptoms)
- 10 days from the onset of symptoms (as long as you are no longer symptomatic)

If you are advised differently by track and trace or a medical professional, you should follow that advice.

For a positive test:

If a St Peter's child tests positive for coronavirus over the half-term holiday, we need to know about it.

If this happens email stpetersholidaycovid@gmail.com give us the details and a phone number. As we will need to contact the rest of the bubble to inform them to self-isolate.

This email address is only for a positive case for a pupil of St Peter's, not for any other member of the household or any other reason. Only emails about a positive case in a St Peter's pupil will be responded to
