### **Packed lunches**

As a school we always promote healthy eating to all our pupils. We provide a well-balanced, nutritional school lunch from our school kitchens that confirms to nutritional standards set for schools. Alternatively, children can bring their own packed lunch from home. If you choose to send your child with a packed lunch from home, we do ask that it is nutritional and well balanced. We do not allow children to bring in any food items containing nuts, fizzy drinks or sweets but children can bring in a small wrapper bar type biscuit e.g. Penguin bar or Club biscuit but not anything larger than that as long as it forms part of a well-balanced packed lunch.

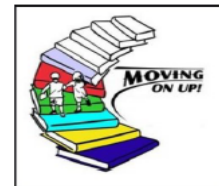
I hope this clears up any confusion regarding approach.
