Communication and Language

We will be focusing on listening skills and following simple instructions. The children will have opportunities to offer explanations for why things happen and extending their vocabulary.



Literacy

We will be reading texts such as Polar Bear, Polar Bear, what do you Hear? The Bus is for Us, The Hundred Decker Bus, Big Yellow Digger, Emergency, and The Three Little Pigs. We will be developing comprehension skills. Phonics will develop children's segmenting and blending skills. This will help to read and write simple words and sentences.

We will be developing skills to persevere when challenges arise. We will be learning about people who help us. We will be developing our ability to show sensitivity towards others.

Understanding the World

We will be observing changes within the natural world around us and linking this to winter and spring. We will look at snow, frost, cold and ice.
