## UPDATES AND INFORMATION

### Sports Day!

We are very excited for our first Sports Day together on the field for a while here at St Peter's!

Sports Day afternoons are on the following dates:

30<sup>th</sup> June for Reception, Y1 and Y2

1<sup>st</sup> July for Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6

The back gate onto the Silkin Way will open at 1:20pm, for a 1:30pm start. **This will be the only access to school for sports day.**

The children will be taking part in a range of racing events.

Children who come 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> will earn points for their House (3 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 1 point for 3<sup>rd</sup>).

We will then announce the winning house at the end of the afternoon.

You will be directed to a spectator area on your arrival on the school field where you will be able to enjoy the afternoon's events.

Children will then go back to their classrooms; collect their belongings and you can pick them up from their usual end of day spot once dismissed by their teacher. Please **do not** collect your children directly from the field at the end of the afternoon.

You make take photographs of **your child only** and these must **not** be uploaded to any form of social media. By following this rule, we can continue to allow photographs to be taken. If we become aware of parents not following this request, we would have to withdraw photographs at future events and we don't want to do that.

Please bring your own picnic blankets or camping chairs to stay comfortable while watching the events! The Friends of St Peter's will be selling refreshments so please support them if you can (see the attached newsletter from The Friends).

Children **MUST** bring a water bottle and a hat with them on their Sports Day.

Reception, Y1 - please come to school in your P.E. kits on Thursday.

Y2 – please come to school in your uniforms (arms and legs to be covered for Mosque visit) and bring your P.E. kits with you.

Y3, Y4, Y5 and Y6 – please come to school in your P.E. kits on Friday.

We look forward to seeing you and we hope you enjoy your afternoon!
