Here at the Telford Childrens Autism Hub, we are excited to bring you our first Newsletter since opening our doors in January 22. These past months have been an incredibly busy time for the new team, and this is an opportunity to introduce ourselves to our families across Telford and Wrekin. There will be many people who know me from my role within the SENDIASS Team and my knowledge and skills gained over time within the area of Special Educational Needs and Disabilities and in supporting families with Autism have been invaluable in providing me with an opportunity to be involved in this new Service.

We want to be able to share with families the support that we provide, listen to our parents/carers, children and young people to ensure that the service is led by their voices, what works well and the challenges they may face.

The hub is a place where families can come together and share positive times together. We encourage children and young people by supporting their confidence, promoting their independence, sharing with others and by doing so supporting their transition into adulthood.

A significant part is to enable children and young people to feel included within their communities and feel connected. We have spent time raising our profile and continue to raise awareness of Autism to the wider community.

Our new team who will be introducing themselves, bring with them a wide range of skills and have been working hard to deliver family support in a range of ways throughout the Summer including a range of family activities, Coffee and Chat Sessions, Workshops and we have been out and about at awareness raising events to ensure that we are reaching a wide audience.

We also welcome to the team Nicola King who is our specialist advisor from Autism West Midlands who provides individual advice sessions for parents/carers and supports our training workshop delivery.

We also acknowledge that parents who may have some worries about their child will speak to their school or nursery. We have been visiting local schools and informing nurseries and Post 16 providers of our service and are now starting to see more families being signposted to us.

We have some planned activities coming up throughout the next few months and we really would love to see new faces and new ideas to support the service development.

It has been great to see the children and young people who attend the hub growing in confidence as they attend our sessions, and we hope to be able to share their stories with you.

From the team and I we would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone who has been involved in supporting us over the initial months.
