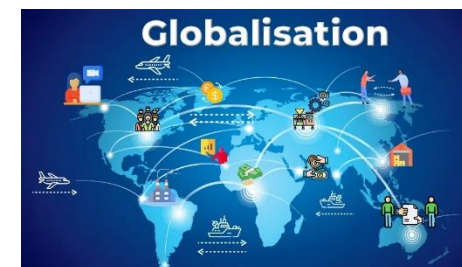

Specific Knowledge to be covered (linked to National Curriculum):

What is globalisation?

Understand what globalisation is and when it began. Understand why the development of transport has been important to globalisation.

How has globalisation changed the way we communicate?

Identify how communication has changed. Understand that internet usage is not globally equal. Know the advantages and disadvantages of changing communication.

How does globalisation affect trade?

Understand what trade is and how it has changed. Understand how trade can bring advantages and disadvantages of changing communication.

What does globalisation have to do with fashion?

Understand what 'fast fashion' is.

Review the positive and negative impacts of the globalised clothing industry.

List where clothes were made and locate countries on a map.

Explain the impact of clothes being exported so far on the environment and people making them.

What does globalisation have to do with food?

Identify which are the most powerful global food companies. Define TNC.

Identify positive and negative impacts of the globalised food industry.

Where will globalisation lead us?

Identify trends in inequality between countries.

Explore the ways in which globalisation has made the world better and worse.

Predict how these are likely to continue in the coming years.

What impact has globalisation had on your life?

Explain the impact of globalisation on their life.
