Well done Jess, we're very proud of your achievements and it's reflective of the hours of training you put into this sport!!!






Year 3 Newsletter Contributions



In Science year 3 have been investigating water transport in plants using celery, pansy plants and food colouring. Ask them about the water moving through the xylem by capillary action!


