We have also been learning skills in netball this term, focusing on the rules of the game and our footwork. Our games have been a chance for us to display our skills and work as a team to achieve a goal.








Year 6


During this week the Year 6 children have shown amazing perseverance, dedication and maturity in completing their Sats. All adults in school are so proud of their efforts and their desire to do their best.
