# Reception 2020

The online application form for children who are due to start school in Reception 2020 is now available via Telford and Wrekin website, www.telford.gov.uk/admissions

We will be holding a school open day on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2019 at 10am and 1:30pm.

To apply for a Reception 2020 school place parents will need to use the online system.

Attached is a starting school poster that we have been asked to share with you.

#### Please note:

- Parents will need to make an application to the Local Authority of where they are living e.g.
   where they pay Council Tax to
- If a child is attending nursery, they still need to apply for a school place
- The deadline for applying for a school place is 15 January 2020
- There is no guarantee of a place at the school even if a child has been attending their nursery or pre school

- If a child has an Education, Health and Care Plan the closing date is 31 October 2019 for all applications

#### **Books**

The children are choosing a book to take home each day. We are encouraging them to change it each morning. These books are for you to read to them. We are currently working with your children to get to know them better and assess what the next steps are in their learning. We will then be able to send home an appropriate book for them to read to you. The reading record book is for you to record when you have read with your child. We will be holding a meeting in the near future to share our approach to reading and to answer any questions you may have.

It would be very helpful if you could send the reading record book in the book bag to school every day.

Children do not need to bring pencil cases or any additional items to school. These make the book bags very bulky and difficult to store in our trays.

# Earrings and Jewellery

Children should not be wearing earrings to school. If they have only just had their ears pierced, they need to have them taped over before they come to school. Jewellery including necklaces, bracelets and rings should not be worn to school.
