Year 5 Reading Morning

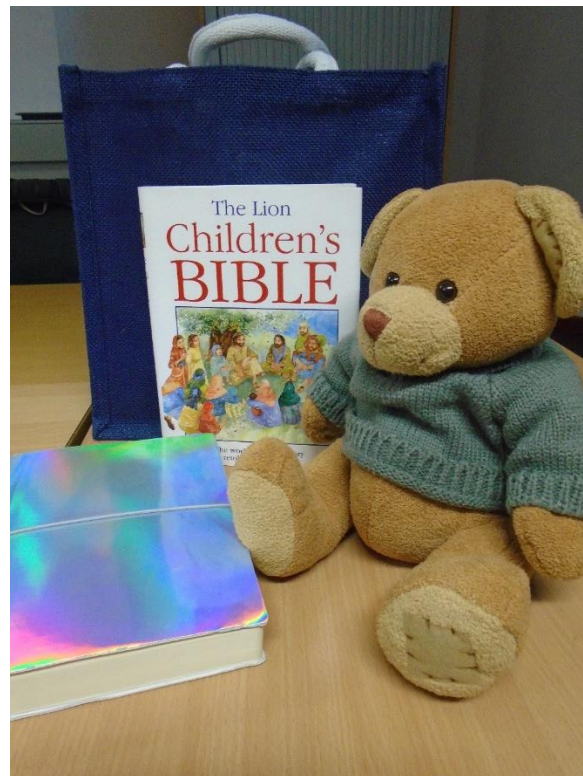
