School Meal Prices:

Telford and Wrekin catering services have informed us that the school meal price increase from £2.30 to £2.35 effective from 1st April. This applies to children in year 3, 4, 5, 6. Children in Reception and years 1 and 2, still receive a free meal via the Universal Infant Free School Meals Scheme.
